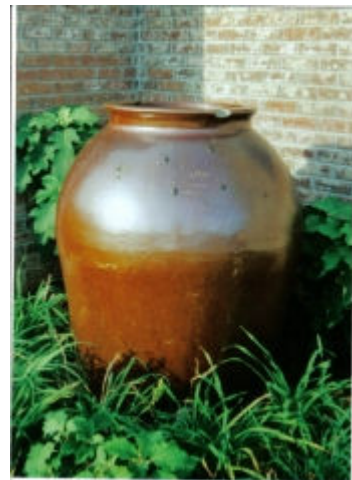

**Reverse paintings on glass** have been popular twice in America's history. The early, circa 1820, paintings usually graced the glass door of clocks, and allowed a view of the moving pendulum. Paintings like this were done by amateur artists on convex, oval glass. Popular in the early 1900's, they usually had a patriotic or pastoral theme. The early reverse paintings used gold leaf rather than craft foil for the reflective areas. Fall classes are forming.
